

Surgical Service Options

Pre-Surgical Home Instructions:

DOGS:

-The patient can have dinner the night before surgery, do not feed or give treats after 9p.m.

-DO NOT FEED THE MORNING OF SURGERY

-The patient can have water throughout the night but pick the water bowl first thing in the morning, so they do not have access to it.

-Ensure to walk your dog before coming to the clinic and ensure that they go pee/poop so that they are resting comfortable in the kennel prior going in for surgery.

CATS:

-The patient can have dinner the night before surgery, do not feed or give treats after 9p.m.

-DO NOT FEED THE MORNING OF SURGERY

-The patient can have water throughout the night but pick the water bowl first thing in the morning, so they do not have access to it.

DROP OFF TIME:

Drop off is between 7:45a.m. and 8:15a.m. in the morning.
